The WDHA Dressage Schooling Show assumed a new life after a four year absence. This year's show was held at the Sunnyview Expo Center, Oshkosh. It featured two days of competition (only one day was offered in the past); and while the numbers of entries were very small, the event brought raves of appreciation from the participants. Most of the competitors were new to dressage; and for some of them, it was their first dressage show.

Rides started at 10:00 am both days and were completed by 1:30. Because the actual competition was so short, both judges offered "Ask the Judge" sessions following the judging; and in Judge Tracy Dikkers' case, she offered free coaching sessions for several riders.

Point Championships. Champion Youth Rider was Taylor Anne Thompson, riding Havana X (68.125). Champion Junior Rider was Kaele Grunski riding Far Beyond (63.750). Champion Senior Rider was Victoria Morrow, riding Darkest Mercy (67.500). Champion Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian was Lederhosen (63.750), ridden by Malinda Zielke. All winners received a trophy and championship ribbon.

Sunday's show offered 2 High Point Championships. High Point Junior Rider was Taylor Anne Thompson, riding Havana X (61.875). High Point Senior Rider was Colleen Krantz, riding Grace Kelly HN (64.400). Winners received a dressage saddle pad as a trophy and a championship ribbon.

Special thanks have to go to club volunteers for their time and effort, to Curtis and Dorothy Daye for storing, carting, setting up and tearing down the new dressage ring; to Curtis for ring preparation; to Jackie Luebke-Puetz for a special trip to Oshkosh to help us put the ring up according to dressage specs; to Connie Kienast for scribing both days and for helping clean stalls at the end of the show; to Dorothy Daye for filling in as scribe for the first rides on Sunday. As always, thanks go to Candy Ziebell, our show secretary, for a well-planned show schedule, timely ride postings, and even reading ride patterns for some of the competitors.

Thanks also go to Debbie Braley of Camelot Tack Exchange for bringing her tack trailer to the event on Saturday and make available some special discount offers to buyers in need of items, such as riding helmets.

Several of the competitors are from the Oshkosh area, which apparently doesn't offer much in the line of dressage show opportunities. Two of the participants said they would do everything they could to recruit riders for future schooling shows held at the Sunnyview facility. They would love to see another ride in the fall; but would be happy with another opportunity next year.

Dressage and Sport Horse Show

The ninth WDHA Dressage and Sport Horse Show, held June 24-25, 2011, at the Waukesha County Expo Grounds, was blessed with NO RAIN, tho' cloudy skies on Friday and beautiful sunny weather with slight breeze on Saturday.

Horse numbers were up. This year's show saw 59 horses, compared to last year's 48.

And, as always, the show was blessed with its wonderful volunteers. When I see John and Mary Adleman, Paula Roberts, Jackie Luebke-Puetz, Michelle Peplinski, and Don Borth show up, I know the show is in good hands. I really don't know how the show would function without their experience and efficiency. Newbies this year included Trish Joaquin as Show Announcer (she did a fantastic job) and Rachel Rhein and friend/acquaintance Tammy (?) Anderson on bit checks as Ring Steward. Both great fill-ins for someone who couldn't make the show after all. People are so good about stepping in to take care of what needs doing!

I am always and forever grateful to our knowledgeable Show Secretary, Candy Ziebell. She makes my job look easy (not that it is....she just makes it look so!)

Special thanks also to Mike Bell, who offered to supply shavings for the show, eliminating the need for exhibitors to pursue them at local businesses and therefore inconvenience. Mike also did the stall charts, another generous and volunteered undertaking.

Results of the many classes are posted elsewhere on the club website. Results of the show's special high point championships are as follows:

Dah-Ban Arabians High Percentage Dressage Ride Perpetual Trophy: Tie between Roberta Josephs on Hudson KD (Intro B - 70.0%) and Stephanie Eckelkamp on Certified Male (Training 1 - 70.0%)

Arabian High Point Champion: Stephanie Eckelkamp on Certified Male

HA/AA High Point Champion: Robert Josephs on Hudson KD

JTR High Point Champion: Madeline Erce on JW

Alexandrite (Second Level 1 - 62.286%)

ATR High Point Champion: Megan Emery on MSA Jamaica Bey (Intro B - 69.375%)

The popular Team Competition consists of a combination of dressage and sport horse scores and includes three members: two dressage riders with their top two dressage scores, and a Sport Horse competitor, with its top score.

This year's team competition pulled five entries: The Misfits (Kari Augustine on Desiderata Rose; Alaina Meese on Angelena JBM, and Amy Rose-Offord on MD Glenlivet Bask); the Sporty Foxes (Abby Weisenberger on Proteus BPA, Megan Emery on MSA Jamaica Bey, and Juli Goder-Larson on Charismas Winddancer)

Bronze Medal winners were Skipp 2 AL with a total score of 65.641 (Katie Pfeil on TLA Ali Oop, Madeline Erce on JW Alexandrite, and Stephanie Reitter on Bremerton DV).

Silver Medal winners were All in the Family with a total score of 66.225 (Stephanie Eckelkamp on Certified Male, Kate Wiggert-Johnson on Rain Afire, and Jan Wiggert with Majority Rules).

Gold Medal winners were Wishful Thinking with a total score of 67.550 (Catherine Bauer with Takeheart, Haley Bristol with Denero, and Rachel Rhein with Don't Toi with Me JIF)

The show ran smoothly, with only a few small surprises, such as the school bus that presented us Friday morning with 40 pre-school youngsters from the All About Learning Day Care Center on Silver Springs Drive. They were a remarkably well-behaved bunch; and lots of little hands went in the air during a short Q & A session following a dressage ride. Of course, the questions were things like "How does a horse walk?" and "How do you comb a horse's tail?" and "What is that?" - pointing to the fence post supporting the boarded show ring. I told the All About Learning Coordinator that it was unfortunate we hadn't known beforehand that they were coming; we could have had lots of coloring sheets and informational handouts for them. As it was, I sent a thank you note and a box of coloring sheets, AHA colored info pages, and blank greeting cards to the school on Tuesday, inviting them back next year with advance notice so we can plan accordingly.

Great opportunity for a T.A.I.L. program!!

The preliminary financials show this year's Dressage & Sport Horse show made a profit. Not great, but encouraging in these difficult economic times.

Again, my heartfelt thanks to the volunteers who make the show happen, in particular to Rachel Rhein and dad and mother, Mike and Jill Rhein, for loading, hauling, unloading, setting up, taking down, reloading and hauling our new dressage ring (which, BTW, looks pretty snazzy). Thanks also to Gail Rentmeester and Vicki Dalton for help setting up on a very wet Thursday. And to Nancy Miller and Laota Hoeft and friend for moving C to the east Friday evening (dressage riders understand!)

If I've overlooked anyone whose help made the show run more smoothly, my abject apologies. The show wouldn't run without you!
