WDHA Futurity/Maturity Changes

The late fees for halter and performance futurities have been reduced to the total of the regular back fees which would have been paid plus a flat rate late penalty of \$25.00. Maturity entries who do not pay their \$50 fee on time will be charged a \$25 penalty per class entered.

One third of the late fee for halter will no longer be used to enter your horse in the Performance Futurity.

At the last WDHA meeting it was decided that our club would like to make a generous donation to a local charity. We felt that the Midwest Horse Welfare Foundation near Pittsville, WI would be a great place to be the recipient of our donation. We looked at their web site and liked what we read, plus we had heard some very positive comments from people that had adopted horses from their facility. This is a charity and a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that is dedicated to finding homes for horses. Everyone who is involved at MHWF is a volunteer and does this out of love and concern for the many horses out there that need a loving home. 100% of all donations and adoption fees go directly into the care of the horses. How many charitable organizations do you know like that?

On Nov. 29, Don Borth and I took a drive out to Midwest Horse to check it out first hand. We were greeted by the Directors, Scott and Karen Bayerl, who promptly went on to tell us how they started this non-profit organization. They originally started out as primarily a "rescue facility". Over the years they have evolved into not only the Midwest's largest rescue and adoption facility but have become a service for people who can no longer keep their horse for a wide variety of reasons. MHWF still follows up on and takes in rescue cases, but also likes to focus on horses that are donated by their caring owners who simply can no longer care for them. In the MHWF Mission Statement they promise to provide only the best homes for these horses, and they do that by having the prospective adopter submit a detailed application along with photos and references.

There are many horses that come to them and they all have a story to tell, from the neglected and abused to the beautiful show horse that owners can no longer keep. People can feel confident that the horses they donate will be well cared for and every effort made to find the right home. Scott and Karen were very appreciative of the gift from WDHA, and said we can be confident that the money will be put to good use. You can just imagine the costs they incur with feeding and caring for the over 30 horses they have at the present time. When Don and I left the farm that day we felt really good inside, like we had a hand in helping the less fortunate horses that are out there.
